

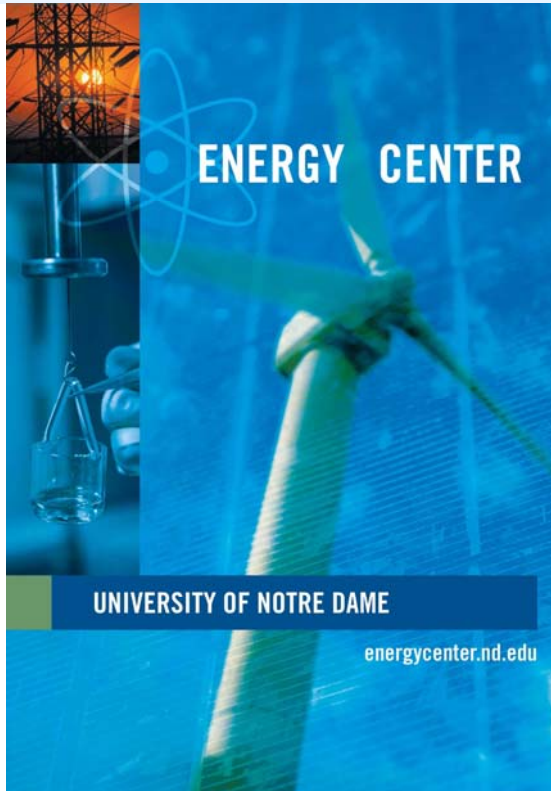

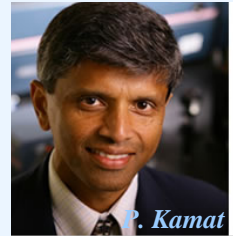

Perspectives on clean coal utilization, CO₂ capture and sequestration, and renewable energy sources



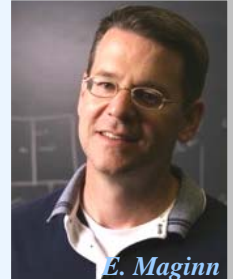

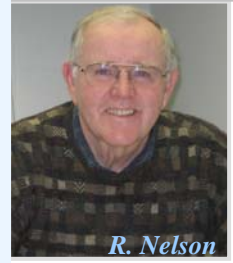
